IMO® began operations in 1994, with the creation of one of the first EMRs, initially called Intelligent Medical Record. The EMR was acquired by Glaxo Wellcome and marketed under the name Healthpoint ACS, later obtained by A4 Health Systems which in turn was later acquired by Allscripts. Following its EMR development, IMO® realized that structured interface terminology was critical to EMRs, the longitudinal care record, and key to semantic interoperability. The IMO® Personal Health Terminology was launched in 1995 and formed the foundation for today's Clinical Interface Terminology family that includes terminology domains in problems and diagnoses, procedures, medications and medical necessity.
